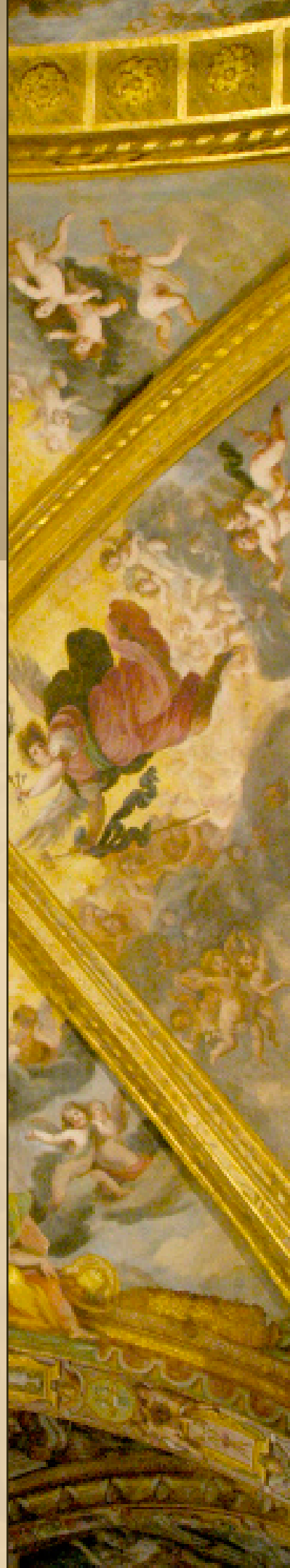

# Rome, the Eternal City

**All roads lead to Rome..and its endless wealth of culture, history and beauty.**

In the ancient world, Rome would be called 'Caput Mundi', the top, the head, the capital of the world. In 1871 it was made the capital of Italy, situated on the Tiber river, with about 2.7 million residents, this is the country's largest city. According to tradition, the ancient city was founded by Romulus (after whom it's named) in 753 BC on the Palatine Hill; as it grew it spread to the other six hills of Rome (Aventine, Caelian, Capitoline, Esquiline, and Quirinal).

Rome was not built in a day, therefore taking a meager day-trip here would not give it the justice it deserves.. so treat yourself to a true Roman holiday and discover the well known sites as well as hidden jems on this 3-night extension.

The romantic atmosphere of La Citta' Eterna (the Eternal City) will influence all who fall under its spell and leave ever-lasting memories. Turn any corner, and you will find yourself in a hidden piazza or a narrow cobbled street, gazing at marble fountains, flower-decked balconies and secret courtyards. Amongst incredible landmarks, such as the Roman Forum, the Vatican Museums, Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona, Castel Sant' Angelo, Spanish Steps, and the Colosseum (to name just a few), you can expect a vast array of shops and markets: from haute-couture designer labels to small antique shops, from mouthwatering food and wine boutiques to leather specialty stores: there is truly something for everyone! So, when in Rome, do as the Romans and explore on foot the amazing city that never ceases to impress both locals & visitors.

# § ROME EXTENSION &

## ☞ Day 1 (Monday) Benvenuto nella Citta' Eterna: Welcome to the Eternal City

Arrival in Rome - check in hotel and get some rest in what the Romans called 'Roma Caput Mundi' (Rome, Capital of the World). Start the trip of a lifetime in one of the world's most beautiful cities! Stay in a historical aristocratic palazzo, turned into a luxury hotel, located just a few steps away from the elegant Via Veneto, the Spanish Steps, and the Trevi Fountain. You'll be in the heart of great dining and shopping, and close to many major sites. Start walking through the ages with a local guide. Among the many sites, our afternoon walk will include the Spanish Steps, the Trevi Fountain, a baroque jewel, the Pantheon (meaning "Temple of all the Gods"), the best preserved of all ancient Roman buildings, and Piazza Navona, among many others. Enjoy a group dinner in a nearby restaurant. Over-night stay in Rome. **D**



## ☞ Day 2 (Tuesday) La Gloria dei Gladiatori: Gladiators' Glory

After breakfast, you'll enjoy the splendors of the classic Roman Empire! Gaze at gorgeous sites during our walk with an expert local guide. We will then walk along the ancient pavement, which crosses the evocative ruins of the Roman Forum, the Curia, the Reggia. You will then admire the Temple of Vesta, the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Costantine. The tour will continue with the visit of the massive structure of the Colosseum (internal visit). Afternoon and dinner on your own. **B**



## ☞ Day 3 (Wednesday) L'arte nei Secoli: Art through the Ages

Accompanied by a local Roman guide we'll enter the Vatican City, where we'll visit the impressive St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican Museums, which will include entrance to the head-tilting and jaw-dropping Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel. Savor the rest of the afternoon and evening on your own. **B**
